



## Inclusion criteria

- ✓ Age between 30 and 70 years
- Have a single articular cartilage lesion in the femoral condyle or trochlea area
- Have undergone prior non-surgical treatment in the index knee

## **Exclusion criteria**

- O Have a BMI greater than 35 kg/m<sup>2</sup>
- Have undergone prior surgical treatment for the cartilage defect
- O Have an existing prosthesis in the index knee
- Have a bone disease that impacts bone quality
- Have rheumatoid arthritis
- Have a known immunodeficiency
- Have known allergies to Cobalt-Chrome alloy or Titanium
- O Have any contraindication to MRI
